The following membership applications were read: Diane Skoy and Kirstin & Ben Farnworth

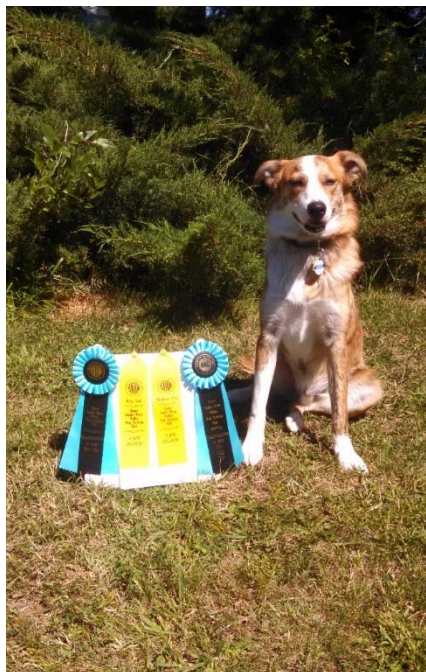
Carl Friedrich made a motion for adjournment. Steven Olson seconded. Passed
