

Upper Snake River Valley Dog Training Club Achievement of Excellence Award General Guidelines:

Barbara Friedrich (1939-2016) was an advocate for dogs and handlers. An active member of the Upper Snake River Valley Dog Training Club (USRVDTC) for many years, she successfully competed with multiple dogs in Obedience, Rally, Tracking and helped many other dog/handler teams reach their goals. Barbara gave freely of her time and talents to further the objectives of the club and its members. The Achievement of Excellence Award has been established in Barbara's honor to recognize dog/handler teams for their success and in memory of Barbara's many accomplishments and friendship to all.

The annual award is determined through points earned between November 1st and October 31st. There are eleven categories in which teams can accumulate points. Eight AKC events: Conformation, Agility, Obedience, Rally, Scent Work, Tracking, Trick Dog, and CAT. Three AKC recognized events: Flyball, Dock Diving, and Barn Hunt.

Requirements and Eligibility: 1) This award recognizes the 'team' collaboration of dog and handler. Only points acquired by a single dog/handler team will be counted toward the award.

2) A team must accumulate points in a minimum of three different areas to be eligible for the annual award.

3) Each dog/handler team may be awarded only once in the dog's lifetime.

4) Dogs crossing over during the qualifying period may still be eligible for that year's award posthumously.

5) All handlers applying must have been an active member of USRVDTTC for one year as of the beginning date for the year's point accumulation period. The handler must have assisted in at least two USRVDTTC competitions.

Scoring:

Points may be earned for qualifying legs in any of the eight categories during the qualifying period of November 1st through October 31st. Results and application must be received by November 10th following the close of the period. Schedule A outlines points to be awarded per leg by category and class.

Application:

The completed application (available at www.usrvdte.org) including documentation of qualifying legs must be received at USRVDTTC, 994 Lowell Drive, Idaho Falls, ID 83402, by November 10th each year.

Documentation must be third party confirmed. AKC provides a report for a fee of all events and points (www.apps.akc.org/apps/store go to competitor reports, Individual Dog Award Record and Points Progression). Other approved organizations also provide similar reports.

Award:

The Vice President will review all applications received by November 10th and determine the year's recipient based on total points accumulated. In the case of a tie, the team with the most advanced titles will prevail. Any disputes of the Vice President's decision should be addressed in writing to the USRVDTTC Board of Directors, 994 Lowell Drive, Idaho Falls, ID 83402.

The Award will be presented at the Club's annual Christmas party.
